

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a sum of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) was set up in the Tribal budget for Fiscal Year 1956 in Account No. W-91-50 PMA matching funds and

WHEREAS, the sum of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) was also set up for relief juniper control in the Fiscal Year 1956 budget

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Account No. W-91-50 be set aside for relief juniper work under the same conditions and supervision as W-91-40 relief juniper control.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Agency Land Operations Officer under the direct supervision of the Superintendent be hereby instructed to properly supervise all expenditures of these accounts.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 5, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
