

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, and

**WHEREAS**, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board recommends to the Council for approval a general operating expense budget for operation of the Enterprise during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1956 and ending December 31, 1956, said budget prepared and recommended in accordance with the plan of operation for the Enterprise, and

**WHEREAS**, the plan of operation for the tribal enterprise was approved by the Acting Area Director on November 23, 1954, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the attached budget for general operating expenses in the total amount of eighty-three thousand, two hundred eighty-six dollars and fifty cents (\$83,886.50) is hereby approved for expenditure for operation of the Enterprise for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1956 and ending December 31, 1956, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is hereby approved for transfer to the Enterprise Account from tribal funds on deposit with the Treasurer of the United States. This advance of tribal funds to the Enterprise Account shall be made on a capital investment basis and repayment shall not be required. Said funds to be expended in accordance with the items listed in the Budget attached hereto and a part hereof, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the amount authorized in the budget for any specific item may be increased by not to exceed twenty per cent (20%) from savings accrued from any other item or items, PROVIDED, such transfer of funds is approved in writing by the Chairman (or Acting Chairman) of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 3, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) and (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
