

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to construct certain recreation enterprise projects during fiscal year 1955-1956, and

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution No. 55-15 Tribal Budget fiscal year 1955-1956 did not provide funds for the construction of recreation enterprise projects, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Tribal Budget Resolution No. 55-15 be hereby amended to provide for expenditure of additional funds for the construction of recreation enterprise projects in the sum of one-hundred six thousand, six-hundred thirty-six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$106,636.75) from tribal funds on deposit with the Treasurer of the United States. Said funds shall remain available for expenditure until respective projects are completed or until officially cancelled by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 13, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) and (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 26, 1936 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
