RESOLUTION OF THE OF THE OF THE FORT APACHS INDIAN RESERVATION

THERMAS, Mr. G. L. Heel, of Holbrook, Arizona has an approved mining lease on the Fort Apache Reservation, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Weel has requested a site for a mill to be located on tribal land other than that now under lease to him, therefore

THE THE RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Nocl's request be granted on an area of tribal land not to exceed twenty (20) acres. The Chairman of the Council is hereby authorized to execute a lease or the Superintendent of the Agency to issue a permit, either document to be in accordance with the Constitution of the Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 4, 1955 duly acopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the white Mountain Abache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe retiried by the Tribe en August 15, 1930 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1930 pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 13, 1934 (hd Stat. 984).
