

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 26 the Tribal Council authorized the possession, consumption and sale of alcoholic beverages on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the policing of said ordinance will be at the sole expense of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to assume strict surveillance in the sale of spirituous liquors.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that no liquor licenses be issued to any individual, association, partnership or cooperation to sell spirituous liquors on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation except to the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on February 12, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (m) and (o) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 13, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
