RESOLUTION OF THE . WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe will frequently need assistance to obtain loans from banks and other lending institutions, and
- WHEREAS, several large enterprises are now being proposed by the tribe for the benefit of members wherein loans will have to be made to the said members, and
- WHEREAS, an expanded tribal loan program is planned whereby tribal funds will be available for loans to members, associations and enterprises, and
- WHEREAS, such a program will require the services of a qualified loan examiner.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a position of Loan Examiner, GS-9, be established and that the position be filled from existing Bureau of Indian Affairs personnel or from a register of Civil Service eligibles.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salary and expenses of this position be paid from appropriated tribal funds not to exceed eight thousand six hundred forty dellars (\$8,640.) for the last quarter of Fiscal Year 1958 and Fiscal Year 1959 and for each succeeding year an amount sufficient to pay the salary and expenses of the position.

The foregoing resolution was on February 27, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribel Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
