## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe entered into an atterney's contract with Earry DeRose on or about the 5th day of August, 1956 for a period of two years, and
- WHEREAS, when the contract was executed the Tribal Geundil did not anticipate that it would prevail upon the Tribal itteracy to assist the Triba in developing not only its natural resources but also its human resources, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was of the spinion that the Tribal Attorney would spend approximately three or four days a month on tribal business, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, subsequent to the attorney's contract, realized that it was demanding of the Tribal Attorney from fifteen to twenty days a month of the Tribal Attorney's time, and
- WHEREAS, after the execution of the said contract through close association with the Tribal Council and our people and in fighting to protect our rights the Tribal Attorney has acquired a deep insight into the Indians problems and places their selfare above all others, and
- WHEREAS, because of the above facts the Tribal Council on its own initiative by Resolution No. 57-45 amended the attorney's contract and to increase his salary to eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) per month, and
- WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Indian Affairs has requested additional reasons for increasing said salary.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal General of the White Mountain
  Apache Tribe that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs take cognizance
  of the fact that Barry DeRose, Tribal Attorney for the White Mountain
  Apache Tribe is not being paid a Malary commensurate with the time
  and type of services he is rendering to the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Pribal Council reaffirms its Resolution No. 57-45 and requests the Councisioner of Indian Affairs to approve the amendment to the attorney's sentrate heretofare submitted.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached memorandum entitled "Additional Information and Justification To Substantiate An Increase In Compensation", which memorandum their not, however, state all of the services the Tribal Attorney has rendered to the Tribe. The attached to this resolution shall be made a part thereof.

The foregoing resolution was on February 27, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (b) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
