## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIES OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Forestdale Logging Unit Contract, which was approved by the Commissioner October 30, 1917 and modified by the Acting Commissioner August 3, 1955, will expire March 30, 1958, and
- WHEREAS, the contractor, Chlarson and Reidhead Logging Company will be unable to complete the logging on schedule due to adverse weather conditions and steep ground.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Forestdale Logging Unit Contract be extended to December 31, 1958 and all other stipulations therein remain in full force and affect.

The foregoing resolution was on April 7, 1958, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
