RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., contractor of the Maverick Logging Unit, Fort Apache Indian Reservation is also contractor of units on the Apache and Sitgreaves National Forests, and
- WHEREAS, all of this timber is sawed in the McNary mill of the corporation, where the scaling of all of these logs can be done more easily and accurately than in the woods where the scaling is now being done in dust, rain, mud or snow, and
- WHEREAS, the National Forest timber volume to this mill is much greater than the Maverick Unit volume, it is desirable that the U.S. Forest perform the scaling for all this timber entering the mill including the logs covered by the Maverick Logging Unit Contract.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bureau of Indian Affairs enter into a cooperative agreement with the U. S. Forest Service for the scaling of Maverick Logging Unit timber under the supervision and check of the Bureau of Indian Affairs which will fully account to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe all timber from the unit that enters the corporation's McNary mill,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other functions in connection with the Maverick Logging Unit continue under the supervision of the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 12, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
