


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Section X, Item (a) of White Mountain Apache Tribal Council Resolution No. 58-17 was authorized in fiscal year 1959 Tribal Budget in the sum of twenty-eight thousand and eight hundred dollars (\$28,800.00) to complete Smith Park Dam, and

WHEREAS, the lake has filled to capacity, two years ahead of schedule necessary spillway widening is immediately required to save the entire structure.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the above mentioned Tribal Resolution No. 58-17 is hereby amended to make the sum of twenty-eight thousand and eight hundred dollars (\$28,800.00) described above immediately available for use on the above mentioned project.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
