## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the following timber units are available for logging accordance to the Forest Management Plan:

McNary Logging Unit

134 acres.

McKay's Peak Logging Unit

3,000 acres.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that after inventory and appraisal by the Forestry Branch have been approved by the Area Director, these units be advertised for sale to the highest qualified bidder in accordance to regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that one hundred dollars (\$100.00) be made available for newspaper advertisement and that the Chairman and Secretary of this Council be authorized to sign contracts awarded to the purchasers.

The foregoing resolution was on June 26, 1958, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n ) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
