RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHITEAS, the U.S. Housing & Home Finance Agency under ?. L. 815 cannot provide funds for sewage disposal off the construction site, and
- THIRDAS, there is to be constructed in Whiteriver on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation a high school designated as Alchesay High School, and
- FHEREAS, it is of utmost importance to the Tribe that proper educational facilities be provided for the members of the Tribe, and
- MERCAS, there are sufficient funds available in the Township and Water-main Construction Account W-91-110 to install a sewer line of sufficient size in the area adjacent to the school site.
- MON THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribe construct a sewer line approximately 100 feet in length which line shall connect with the existing sewer line now serving the Whiteriver area and the east boundary of the Alchesay High School plet said sewer line to be of sufficient size to serve the maximum requirements of the High School.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cost of constructing said sewer line be paid out of funds new available in the Townsite & Watermain Construction Account W-91-110.

The foregoing resolution was passed on July 15, 1938 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) and (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe. Approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 and ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
