

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, asbestos mining leases numbered 14-20-450-974; -975; -976; -1064; -1065 and -1066 drawn in favor of Asbestos Explorations Company, a limited partnership, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council recognizes its responsibilities toward the economic development of the natural resources of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, Asbestos Explorations Company has made a request for a 30 day extension in which to begin mining operations for the purpose of determining whether asbestos bodies can be uncovered and mined in commercial quantities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Asbestos Explorations Company be allowed 30 days from date of this resolution to begin mining operations and to diligently pursue the development and file a report within 60 days of above mentioned date with the Regional Mining Supervisor, United States Geological Survey, P. O. Box 629, Carlsbad, New Mexico, indicating the work performed, ore uncovered by mining, the ore milled and a plan for continuing operations.

The foregoing resolution was on September 24, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 11 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (b) and (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
