RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE WOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESEAVATION

- where A., on January 7, 1958, by resolution No. 50-15, the Chairman of the Frikal Council was authorized to grant a lease of the manganese mining claims commonly known as Moel Nos. I through 6 located approximately two miles south of the Medicine Hanch House, and
- of the United States Department of the Seological Survey of the United States Department of the Interior, recommended a transportation allowance not to exceed eight (.08) per cent mer long ton (2240 pounds) mile over the shortest feasible route, and
- Tribal Chairman and Secretary did execute a lease with one Virgil Burke and Kent Hail, and
- operformance bond covering said claims and have abundoned same, and
- WERGAS, Louis S. Ellsworth, Jr. and Mary Jean Ellsworth, his wife, desired to lease said mining claims, and
- SHORMAS, the Tribal Attorney was authorized to negotiate a lease for said claims with the said Louis R. Ellsworth, Jr. and Mary Jean Ellsworth, or any other suitable carty, and
- his wife, offered to commence mining operations on said claims within thirty days after a lease was executed by the Tribal Council and noproved by the Secretary of the Interior or his authorized representative, and
- daly executed by Louis 9. Ellsworth, Jr. and Eary Jean Ellsworth, his wife.
- NOT THE HEFORE BE ST RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Anache Tribe in special session that the Chairman be authorized to execute and sign said negotiated lease covering the said mining claims known as Noel Nos. 1 through 6 for and on behalf of the Council with Louis B. Ellsworth, Jr. and Mary Jean Ellsworth, his wife, of Globe, Gila County, Arisons.
- 30 IT YEST HR R SULVED that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs or his authorized representative approved said negotiated lease without advertising.

The foregoing resolution was on the 17th day of December, 1958, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 equinst by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, parsuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b), (1), and (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
