

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, resolution 166 July 29, 1946 designated the East Fork Logging Unit for tribal lumber operations. Resolution 58-11, April 8, 1958 authorized tribal lumber operations in Big Canyon Logging Unit for the year ending March 31, 1959 and,

WHEREAS, authority to cut timber has been on an annual basis to the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company,

BE IT RESOLVED, that authority to cut by this tribal enterprise on the East Fork and Big Canyon Logging units be on a continuous basis and in accordance with the Reservation Forest Management Plan.

The foregoing resolution was on April 1, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
