RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company, a Tribal owned Enterprise, has in the accounts, and located in the lumber yard, one 1952 model Dump Truck and one Refuse Burner both being beyond repair, and
- WHEREAS, the Advisory Board of the Enterprise recommends to the Council that the Enterprise Manager be authorized to sell these items as scrap.
- BE IT RESOLVED, the Manager of the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company, is hereby authorized to sell as junk one 1952 Ford Dump Truck and one Refuse Burner.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Manager is authorized to drop these items from the Equipment Inventory and Accounts of the Company.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for
and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apacha Tribe, pur-
suant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution and
by-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the
Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
