

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tom Brown has requested the Tribe to approve a sale of the old Union Building in McNary to him by the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has no economic interest in said building.

BE IT RESOLVED that the approval is hereby given to Tom Brown to purchase from the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., the McNary Union Building.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
