FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has approved the Constitution and By-Laws of the East Fork-Seven Mile Home Builders, and

WHEREAS, it would be necessary to assign certain lots to construct needed homes on.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Land Board is hereby authorized to grant an assignment to any person approved by the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be authorized and directed to sign any lease agreements as provided in Ordinance No. 44 provided; however, that the Superintendent must first approve the lease agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said lease agreements shall be final if the Tribal Council at its meeting following the signing of the lease does not revoke same.

The foregoing resolution was on March 29, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
