

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Construction Manager, O. J. Arnold, has advised the Council that the present Woods planer now being used at the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company is not of sufficient capacity or of sufficient durability to handle the production of the new sawmill.

BE IT RESOLVED that permission is hereby granted O. J. Arnold to purchase for and on behalf of the Tribe a new, modern up-to-date planer of sufficient capacity to handle the expected production of the new sawmill.

The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
