RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc., has requested permission to survey the following across Indian trust lands of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
 - (a) Extension from new sawmill to Fort Apache, 14.4/24.9 line.
 - (b) Extension from new sawmill to pump site (Whiteriver).
 - (c) New construction between McNary and Whiteriver to augment inadequate #6 Cu. existing line.
 - (d) New extension to Alchesay Fish Hatchery, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe will benefit by the survey and construction of said distribution and transmission lines.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc., is hereby granted permission to make surveys for the above listed distribution and transmission lines, in accordance with their application and maps which are on file in the office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all damages be waived as the Tribe will benefit by the survey and construction of the distribution and transmission lines.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
