

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed of the delays in the payment of tribal obligations, and

WHEREAS, it appears that in the Tribal Enterprises and the Tribal Business Office there has been a duplication of accounting, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes that because of the above and for the further reason that its sound business practice therefore a complete management study made of all Tribal Enterprises and the Tribal Business Office.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Secretary are authorized and directed to enter into a management study contract with the firm of Dennis, Parker & Schmich, Certified Public Accountants at a cost not to exceed fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$1,500 be appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the Treasury of the United States.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Superintendent or the Tribal Attorney are hereby authorized to make available all records, accounting procedures and any other data required by the said accounting firm.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
