## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE HOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the construction of East Fork Loop Road, Route 46, Project No. FAIR 46 (2) was approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs during the Fiscal Years 1964-k965, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau advised the Tribe that force account construction of said road would commence during the month of September 1964, and
- WHEREAS, a survey is being made, to be completed in April 1963, determining the centerline location of said road construction, and
- WHEREAS, there is a possibility of Public Works Acceleration Funds being made available for clearing of said right-of-way, a limitation for clearing is needed prior to completion of surveys and plans.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs be granted a maximum of One Hundred (100) foot width, over the entire Project length, for said clearing and construction with reduced width where possible in order to prevent infringement of tillable land, or previous assignments unless the need arises due to minimum twenty six (26) foot road travelway construction standard.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, by further study to determine the fencing needs along said route construction, furnish and install and maintain all fencing and to replace such fencing as may be removed for construction. Said fencing to be indicated on final plans prior to construction and as accepted by the Agency Superintendent.
- BE IT FURTHER RESCLVED that a copy of this Resolution be furnished the Arizona Congressional Delegation and the Secretary of the Interior.

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Hountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1956 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Hay 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (46 Stat. 984).
