

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 57-49 the Chairman was authorized to execute for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe a joint employment agreement with the Arizona Livestock Sanitary Board wherein the Tribe would pay one-half of the salary of a Livestock Inspector on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and the Arizona Livestock Sanitary Board would pay half of the said salary, and

WHEREAS, said contract was to be for a period of one year terminating June 30, 1959, and

WHEREAS, said contract has never been drafted, and

WHEREAS, the said Sanitary Board and the Tribe have employed said Livestock Inspector according to the approved conditions and pursuant to an oral agreement, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe and the Livestock Association desire to affirm the said oral agreement and to enter into a new agreement for the ensuing year.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of the Tribe a joint agreement with the Arizona Livestock Sanitary Board which agreement will in effect provide, among other things, that the Tribal Council will employ a Livestock Inspector at a salary of \$300.00 per month plus the cost of his necessary transportation expenses and that the state will pay \$150.00 of said salary and the Tribe will match \$150.00 of the Inspector's salary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the agreement is to be effective the first day of February, 1963 for a period of one year ending January 31, 1964.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the oral employment agreement which has been in effect since June 30, 1959 covering the employment of said Livestock Inspector is hereby affirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is to attempt to induce the Livestock Sanitary Board to in addition to paying the \$150.00 per month to also defray one-half of the transportation expenses.

The foregoing resolution was on February 6, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
