

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency has requested a 25 year lease with an option to renew for an additional period of 25 years of the lands now being occupied by the Agency commonly known as the Administrative Site, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe recognizes the importance of providing ample area to the said Agency in order that it may operate its administrative functions in an efficient manner.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Secretary for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a 25 year gratuitous lease with an option to renew for an additional period of 25 years. Said lease covering the area now being occupied by the Fort Apache Agency commonly designated as the Administrative Site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the lease provide, among other things, that if and when the same is terminated all improvements placed upon or within said area shall become the property of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, subject to existing law.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
