

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is being strewn throughout the Whiteriver area garbage, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to establish a garbage pit at an advantageous site.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby established an approximate ten acre sanitary disposal area directly across from the entrance road to the new sawmill in the center of Section T95NRange23E together with an ingress and egress road to said site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Police and its entire organization is hereby held responsible for the policing of the said sanitary disposal area.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
