WHEREAS, Mrs. Mary V. Riley has served her people on the Tribal Council on Committees and as a private citizen in an outstanding dedicated manner, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to show its appreciation to Mrs. Mary V. Riley for her exemplary actions.

BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mrs. Mary V. Riley is hereby given a vote of confidence for her dedicated work to the White Mountain Apaches.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
