

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is continually trying to improve the efficiency of not only its many enterprises, but of its Accounting Department, and

WHEREAS, Dennis, Parker & Schmich, Certified Public Accountants, Phoenix, Arizona, was employed to make a management study and recommendations to improve the function of the Accounting Operation of the Central Accounting Office, and

WHEREAS, the recommendations if followed would not only effectuate a savings to the Tribe, but would insure a more efficient operation thereof.

BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed organization of accounting functions by Dennis, Parker & Schmich, as read to the Council and filed with the Secretary and with the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency, is hereby adopted as a Plan of Operations for the Central Office of the White Mountain Apache Tribe excepting therefrom the recommended Vacation Policy on Page 8 of said plan and the recommended Holidays on Page 9 of said plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby directed to instruct all employees and managers covered by said plan to comply therewith.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
