RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona Industrial Commission has demanded an increase in our advance deposit as required by the Act, based on the payroll experience of the last half of 1962, and
- WHEREAS, the Council has provided this deposit, thus further subsidizing the participating Enterprises and Associations with an asset that does not appear on their books.
- BE IT RESOLVED that all accounts having payrolls processed by the Tribal Payroll Clerk shall be assessed their proportionate share of the amount of deposit required by the Arizona Industrial Commission based on the experience provided by the last half year of 1962, and amended quarterly in the future.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
