

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the hereafter listed items in construction programs were overspent in the amounts needed due to the fact that the Construction and Maintenance Manager and anticipated savings with the budget were not realized, and

WHEREAS, it is a sound financial policy to transfer and appropriate from Tribal funds to cover this overexpenditure.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$5,399.00 for a used rock crusher and washer, the sum of \$10,500.00 for the construction equipment maintenance and the sum of \$12,500.00 for the partial completion of the Permanent Youth Camp or a total of \$28,300.00 is hereby authorized and appropriated from Tribal funds on local deposit by the Tribal Treasurer to cover the said overexpended items.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
