

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there are many unfinished programs on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, there is a dire need to discuss these programs with the Central Office and the Arizona Congressional Delegation, and
- WHEREAS, it is imperative that the Superintendent accompany a delegation to Washington, D. C.
- WHEREAS, the Council nominated Lester Oliver, Fred Banashley, Les Baha and Homer Beatty to attend the National Congress of American Indians Convention, September 8th through the 14th at Bismarck, North Dakota.
- BE IT RESOLVED that Superintendent Robert E. Robinson, Chairman Lester Oliver, Mary V. Riley, Ida Early and Tribal Attorney, Barry DeRose are hereby authorized and directed to proceed to Washington, D. C. for the purpose of discussing and consulting with the Central Office and the Arizona Congressional Delegation regarding programs of vital interest to the White Mountain Apaches.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached agenda be forwarded to the Area Director so that appointments can be arranged with the various departments of government.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a week be scheduled by the said Area Director after the 16th day of August, 1963.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Lester Oliver, Fred Banashley, Les Baha and Homer Beatty are hereby authorized and appointed as delegates representing the White Mountain Apaches to attend the National Congress of American Indians Annual Convention to be held at Bismarck, North Dakota during the week of September 8th through the 14th.

The foregoing resolution was on July 31, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
