## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, General Forest Regulations require consent of the Indian owners for the cutting of timber under permit and the establishment of minimum stumpage rates to be charged, and
- WHEREAS, the Regulations further require that an annual policy statement be prepared by the Superintendent on a calendar year basis covering all particulars and is to be approved by the Area Director.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the schedule of minimum stumpage prices and conditions attached hereto be approved for calendar year 1963 and be submitted to the Area Director for his approval.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
