WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 63-100 the schedule of minimum stumpage prices and conditions were established, and


WHEREAS, the Council desires that green oak, aspen and juniper be included in the timber that can be harvested by Tribal members for their own use as fuel.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that green oak, aspen and juniper be included in the timber that can be harvested by Tribal members for their own use as fuel.

The foregoing resolution was on September 25, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
