WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has approved an extension of the Claims Contract for a period of one year subject to the concurrence in such extension by the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, there is no question but that an extension should be granted.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Claims Attorneys, Cobb-Weissbrodt, Claims Attorneys' Contract extension of one year by the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Morton Lifsin's inclusion as one of the Claims Attorneys is approved.

The foregoing resolution was on September 25, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
