

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE, IT RESOLVED that the Buckskin Blowdown Logging Unit of 180 acres with an estimated volume to be cut of 690,500 board feet principally ponderosa pine be advertised for sale under the following conditions:

- a. That the minimum advertised rates per M. feet B.M. shall not be less than \$3.00 for all species;
- b. That the advertisement be made by circulars to lumbermen and posted in post offices on and near the Reservation for a period of ten days;
- c. That the contract is approved subject to such changes as may be deemed necessary by the Area Director;
- d. That the Tribal Council requests that this timber be sold by sealed bids;
- e. That the Chairman and Secretary of the Tribal Council be authorized to execute the contract and necessary extensions or modifications for and in behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe;
- f. That the net proceeds from the sale of timber on this unit be deposited to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on October 10, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
