

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, H. R. 8916 has been introduced by Mr. Haley, and

WHEREAS, said bill provides for the protection of the American Indians from the flooding of their lands by any department or agency of the United States before suitable provision has been made for their relocation, and

WHEREAS, the United States Government owes a moral duty to not dispossess Indians from their lands without proper relocation or compensation.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council unanimously endorses H. R. 8916.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to our Arizona Congressional Delegation.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1, (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
