

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. C. E. Rupp has requested a month to month tenancy of a certain area of building in Whiteriver in order to establish a wholesale plumbing and supply business, and

WHEREAS, this would be a benefit to the Construction Enterprise, in that, the Enterprise would not need to have such a large inventory of plumbing supplies.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are authorized to enter a month to month tenancy with the said C. E. Rupp for a period not to exceed one year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Area Director is hereby requested to establish a fair rental value of the business to be charged by the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are authorized to sign said tenancy agreement upon ascertaining the said fair rental value.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent is hereby requested to issue a traders permit upon execution of the above tenancy agreement.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
