

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the U. S. Public Health Service has agreed to construct water and sewage systems for the Diamond Creek Turn-off Housing Development, and


WHEREAS, an agreement had been requested by the U. S. Public Health Service; such agreement having been read to the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement for the construction of a water and sewage system at the Diamond Creek Turn-off Housing Development between the White Mountain Housing Authority, the U. S. Public Health Service and the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on October 28, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
