## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Regulations require that for each calendar year an annual policy and procedural statement be prepared by the Superintendent for the sale and use of minor forest products such as fuelwood, post poles, transplants, and small amounts of sawlogs, and
- WHEREAS, the minimum prices and conditions established in Resolutions 63-100 and 63-125 are equitable for the calendar year 1964, and
- WHEREAS, Form 5-924a, the timber cutting permit for use by organized tribes, requires that the permits be issued by the Tribal Chairman and be approved by the Superintendent, and
- WHEREAS, in order to expedite the issuance of Form 5-924a, the following named Bureau employees of the Branch of Forestry are designated to act for the Tribal Chairman as Issuing Officers and who will also be the Superintendent's delegated representative as Approving Officers: Harold E. Storie, Harry Kallander, Andrew E. Mihok, Richard E. A. Lyon, and Broadus Bones.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the minimum prices and conditions established in Resolutions 63-100 and 63-125 for certain forest products is hereby re-established for the calendar year, 1964.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said designated officers are hereby authorized to issue Form 5-924a as above-provided.

The foregoing resolution was on March 19, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
