## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the United States Geological Survey has made a study of the values of sand, gravel and cinders on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and have recommended that certain royalties be charged for same, and
- WHEREAS, the Council desires to follow the recommendation of the Geological Survey.
- BE IT RESOLVED that hereafter no permits shall be issued for less than fifteen cents (.15) per ton for screenings, ten cents (.10) per ton for Select, ABC, MA, five cents (.05) per ton for borrow and thirty-five cents (.35) per ton for cinders.

The foregoing resolution was on May 28, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
