

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, certain persons are now drilling wells on the reservation without approval of the Council or the Superintendent.

BE IT RESOLVED that any person drilling a well on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, shall submit to the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, a log of the well, including but without limitation to, all information relative to the pumping capacity of said well.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when any person relinquishes the land upon which a well is located that he be required to leave said well drilled thereon intact.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Ski Club and the Assembly of God Church at Canyon Day are hereby granted permission to drill wells on their respective properties subject to the above conditions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Superintendent are authorized to issue any well drilling permits subject to the above conditions.

The foregoing resolution was on February 11, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
