

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has approved construction of a Job Corps Camp to be located on Kinishba Flat, and

WHEREAS, the program of work to be performed by Job Corpsmen includes the construction of recreational facilities.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council approves the use of any recreational developments or facilities constructed under the auspices of the Job Corps Camp of the Office of Economic Opportunity by the general public under such ordinances and regulations as the tribe has and will adopt for this purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on March 26, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
