## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Priscilla Seymour, William Bones, Mrs. Sinew Riley, Gin Riley and Chester Kinney are in close proximity to areas wherein the Tribal Council has requested the U. S. Public Health Service that water and sewage facilities be constructed, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council that these persons be included in the areas being requested for said water and sewage construction.

BE IT RESOLVED that the U. S. Public Health Service is hereby requested to include the above-named persons in any proposed water and sewage construction program.

The foregoing resolution was on April 7, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
