


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs plans to develop a water system in connection with the Cibecue School.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 65-20 is amended to read as follows:

That the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby authorized to explore for water on and off the school site and further authorized to install an adequate water system to serve the Cibecue Day School.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
