


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Resolution No. 65-15, February 11, 1965, authorized permit stumpage rates and rates for other miscellaneous forest products and also designated certain Bureau employees to act for the Council Chairman as Issuing Officer and also the Superintendent's delegated representative as Approving Officer, and

WHEREAS, a Bureau forester is now residing at Cibecue who will be available to issue permits.

BE IT RESOLVED that David E. Reinhold, Forester, be authorized to issue Timber Cutting Permits in the capacities described above.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
