

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Scenic Railroad, Inc. Taylor, Arizona, desires to obtain cinders from the McNary Cinder Pit, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, it is economically beneficial to the Tribe to sell cinders.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the said White Mountain Scenic Railroad, Inc. be authorized to remove 6,000 cubic yards of cinders from the McNary Cinder Pit paying therefore, the sum of 35 cents per cubic yard and removing said cinders on or before the 11th day of November, 1965.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Scenic Railroad, Inc. furnish certified weight and/or volume slips monthly to the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
