RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribe has leased the Big Cienega Ski Run to the White Mountain Winter Sports Club, and
- WHEREAS, the ski run provides much needed revenue to the area during the winter season, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Winter Sports Club desires that Apache County maintain the road from State Highway 73 to the Big Cienega Ski Run, and
- WHEREAS, approximately one-quarter (1/4) mile of the Big Cienega Ski Run Road is on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED that Apache County is hereby requested to maintain said section of road.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Board of Supervisors of Apache County.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
