

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 65-47 and 65-48 the Tribe provided the sum of \$20,000.00, said sum representing 25% of the cost of constructing North Fork, McNary, East Fork and Carrizo Community Buildings, and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 65-48 the Chairman and Superintendent requested to make application with the Home and Finance Agency of the U. S. Government to contribute 75% of the cost of the construction of these buildings, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe can secure 75% of the cost of building one community facility from the Department of Housing and Urban Development, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is in dire need of a gymnasium and community facility in Whiteriver, and

WHEREAS, the cost of said community-gymnasium facility is estimated at \$200,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development would contribute \$150,000.00 of the said sum.

BE IT RESOLVED that SECTION IX B 1. of Resolution No. 65-49 is amended by providing that the \$20,000.00 provided therein be used for funds for the construction of a community-gymnasium building in Whiteriver, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an additional sum of \$30,000.00 is hereby appropriated from Tribal Funds to be further used as matching funds for the construction of the said community-gymnasium facility in Whiteriver, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to file with the Department of Housing and Urban Development on any other governmental agency the necessary application to secure a 75% of the cost of building the said community-gymnasium facility in Whiteriver, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized to sign for and on behalf of the Tribe any and all other documents necessary to consummate the construction of the said building.

The foregoing resolution was on January 25 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) & (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
