RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, surveys made by the Community Action Director and the Community Action Advisory Committee indicate a considerable number of chronically unemployed people residing on the reservation who are not able to secure training under other publicly financed programs, and
- WHEREAS, we are aware of the terribly unsanitary and blighted condition of the area below what is known as Blueberry Hill and which is located in the immediate vinicity of the Whiteriver Rodeo and Fairgrounds, and
- WHEREAS, there is a definite and dire need for the betterment and beautification of communities and community centers, and general cleanup of our reservation parks and public campgrounds, and
- WHEREAS, there is much to be done in the maintenance, improvement and protection of our forests and wildlife areas, and in our roadside and cemetaries cleanup and beautification.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Community Action Director and the Community Action Advisory Committee be requested to prepare an application to the Community Action Program, Branch of the Office Economic Opportunity to conduct such a Community Betterment and Beautification Program on our reservation under the Nelson Amendment Guidelines as soon as possible, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe authorize and direct the Chairman to sign all necessary documents to enable the Tribe to participate in such a program.

The foregoing resolution was on March 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
