

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Concrete and Gravel Enterprise is now becoming stabilized, and

WHEREAS, in order to operate it at a profit and to keep tribal members fully employed it is necessary to construct buildings outside the Whiteriver area.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby directed to request the Area Director for permission to construct individual buildings outside the Whiteriver area.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
