## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has advised the Tribal Council that the agricultural extension program, Branch of Land Operations, expenses are not being funded for fiscal year 1967, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council considers this a very important program and much needed by the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Application of Community Action Program, Component No. 8, Agricultural and Homemaker's Services under the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 is hereby approved.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary to make application for this program.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
